Guidelines for Organizing NCTS Courses

The National Center for Theoretical Sciences (hereafter referred to as NCTS) organizes or co-organizes courses with special topic or basic courses, to broaden students' academic horizons and encourage interdisciplinary collaboration.

The Course:

1. Course co-organized by NCTS and collaborating institution/department may grant credit hours according to regulations of the university in which the course is held.
2. The course may be of a special topic, comprising various subtopics (it is required that for each subtopic, at least three hours of lecture is arranged). The course may also be important basic mathematic course designed for graduate students and senior undergraduates.
3. Organizer(s) may invite domestic scholars or those from overseas to organize or lecture the course together.
4. NCTS offers lecture fee for lecturers (except for those who are in the meantime organizers of the course); please refer to NCTS' guidelines for organizing talks and courses.

The Application:

Organizer(s) should submit the application one month ahead of the scheduled course, which includes the program, list of lecturers and their talk titles, and expected achievement of the course. NCTS will support the course with approval of the Executive Committee.
