Aim & Scope

Algebraic Geometry in East Asia (AGEA) is the largest conference in the dedicated to algebraic region geometry. It is co-organized with research partners from Japan, China, Korea, Vietnam, and Singapore and takes place approximately every three participating among the years institutes. AGEA has a history spanning around 25 years, beginning with its inaugural event at Kyoto University in 2001. Since then, the conference has rotated locations: it was held in Vietnam in 2005, Korea in 2008 and 2023, Taiwan in 2011, Peking in 2013, and Tokyo in 2016. Thanks to the ongoing support from NCTS and partner institutes, the conference has gained significant international recognition. In 2025, Taiwan will host AGEA for the second time, with the event taking place at National Cheng Kung University in Tainan.
